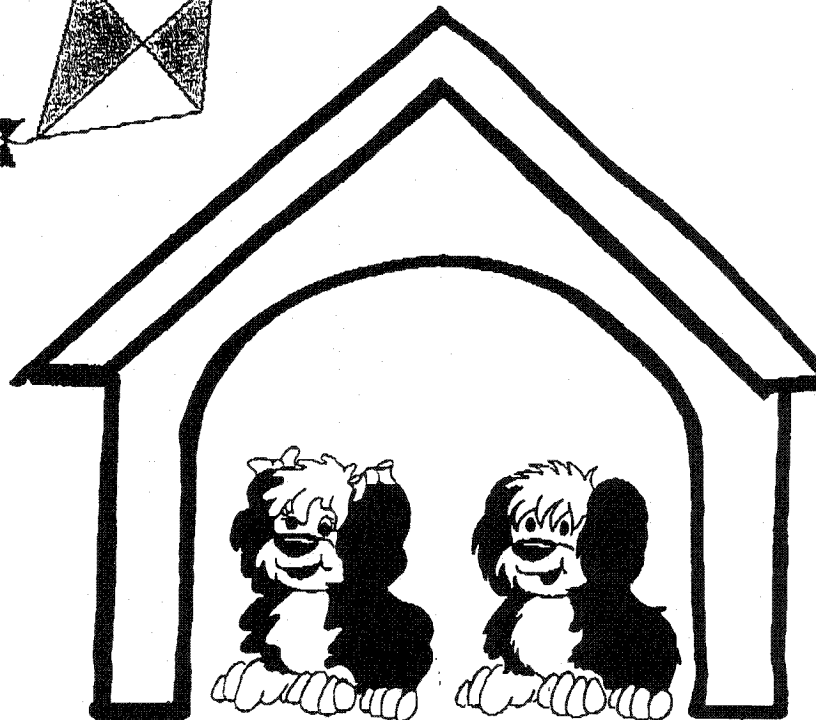
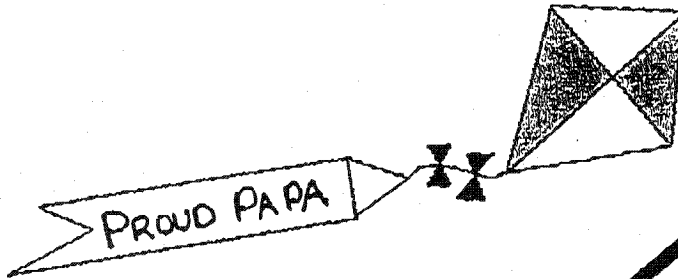

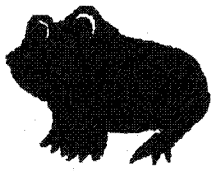


Happy Easter

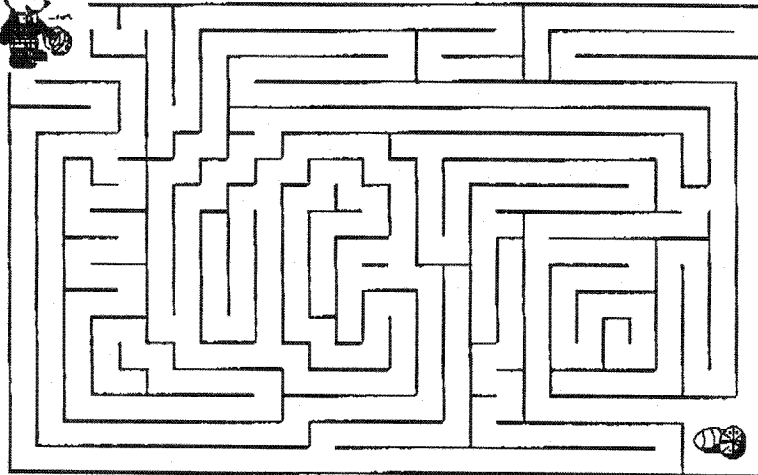

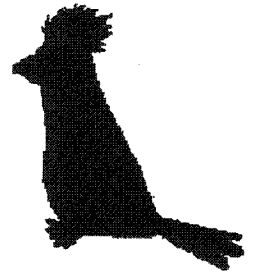
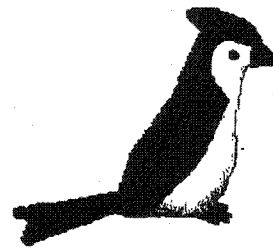

Can you name these birds?

BABY FOOD JAR GARDENS

What you need

- baby food jar w/lid
- small dried/silk flowers
- rolling pin
- craft or hot glue
- homemade (store bought) play dough

PLAY DOUGH RECIPE:

- 1 cup flour
- 2 tsp. Cream of tartar
- ½ cup salt
- 1 cup warm water
- 1 tsp. Oil
- food coloring



HOW TO MAKE IT

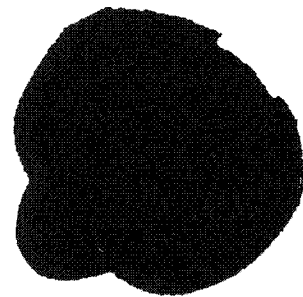
1. **PLAYDOUGH**-Mix all ingredients, adding Food coloring last. Stir over medium heat until Blended smooth. Place in airtight bag when cool.
2. **MAKING THE GARDEN**- Roll out play dough w/rolling pin. Use the mouth of the jar as cookie Cutter(don't use lid or you won't be able to close The jar). Hot glue(adults only) the play dough Into the lid and wait 10 seconds. Stick flowers Into the dough. Leave lids on a cookie sheet to Dry overnight. When play dough is dry, screw lid On carefully. You can write the name on the jar Or decorate it anyway you'd like.

Lady Bug Magnet

Rating: very easy

What you need

- red sheet of craft foam
- black sheet of craft foam
- hole punch
- scissors
- pen
- 2 different sized circular objects to trace
- tacky glue
- heavy duty magnet



How to make it

1. Trace around the smaller object onto the black craft foam.
2. Trace around the larger object onto the red craft foam. Cut
3. Cut red circle in half.
4. Use the hole punch to punch out black spots for ladybug.
5. Cut a shape for the head (see photo).
6. Glue pieces together using the photograph as a guide.
7. Glue the magnet on the back of the ladybug.
8. Let dry completely.
9. Use on refrigerator, file cabinets, or any magnetic surface!
