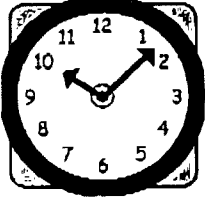
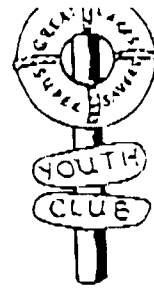

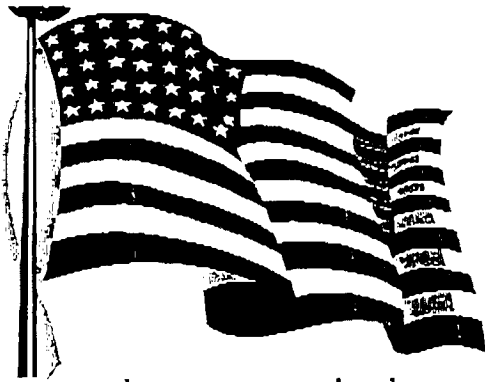
Wacky Wednesday

Memorial Day is May 27, 2002.

Henry C. Welles, a man from Waterloo, NY, suggested that the patriots who died in the Civil War should be honored by decorating their graves. General John B. Murray formed a committee to plan a day to devote to the dead. The townspeople made wreaths, crosses and bouquets for each veteran's grave.

The first Memorial Day was on May 5, 1866. The following year the townspeople observed this day. Memorial Day is a holiday that was created to honor and pay our respect for fallen soldiers. Memorial Day was first known as Decoration Day. Decoration Day was officially proclaimed on May 5, 1868 by General John Logan and was first observed on May 30, 1868. In 1882, the name was changed to Memorial Day. In 1971, Memorial Day was made a national holiday to be held on the last Monday of May. Memorial Day is a day to visit the gravesites of loved ones and ancestors and put flowers by their headstones. Small flags are placed by the graves also.

Today, Memorial Day marks the beginning of the summer season in the United States. Many families take advantage of the long weekend to get together for picnics and other early summer activities.
